Roll Call: Missing were Barehill, Buzzard's, Cabin Fever, South Shore, and Xtreme clubs.

Secretaries' Report: Waived. Classic and NorthEast.

Treasurer's Report: Accepted as read. 2007 Budget amendments. Youth championship budget was set to \$6000.00. State championship was set to \$35,000.00. All other expenses were budgeted the same as last year at this time. \$300.00 increase was added for Donation Expense to cover Squam Lakes Science Center.

Tournament Report: A check was given to the Cathedral Camp in Lakeville to secure a deposit for parking for the Long Pond Tournament.

Youth Report: The date for the Youth Tournament is April 14th, Saturday. May dates are not set yet. The finals will have the top ten from the Eastern Mass tournament vs. the top ten from the Western Mass tournament.

Banquet Report: Banquet tickets are available from Mike Tamburello. \$25.00 each. January 13th. Hilltop Steakhouse in Saugus.

Scholarship Report: Nothing at this time. 50/50 brought in \$117.00 this month.

State Team: Tickets are due back from the clubs at the Banquet (latest).

Old Business: All clubs will have to fulfill a Youth requirement in order to fish the State Championship. Youth tournament or Sportsman shows participation will be fine. Mass Bass TBF will have a youth event at the Worcester Sportsman Show.

The PVA has their tournaments posted on their website. This year they have a partnership with Northern Bass Supply. Participants in PVA Tournaments can qualify to win a boat at Northern Bass' TOC by participating through the PVA Tournament trail.

Clubs that have dropped from the Federation are Charles River, Fall River, Metro West, Rod Jockeys, Plymouth Rock, and Wachusett Bassmasters.

New Business: Motion passed to Donate \$300.00 to the NH Squam Lakes Science Center in hopes that we can procure our offsite parking in the Science Center field which is behind the parking area at the ramp. We have been fortunate in the past to have a good relationship with these people and they let us use their property. The Squam Lakes Association is trying to limit the amount of tournaments on the lake as well as the amount of available parking.

The Dept. of Public Safety in NH has committed to acquiring parking space for Tournament fishing which will be away from the Main Lot. By us acquiring our own offsite parking, we will be staying ahead of the game. This donation will be a yearly donation.
